30% Bull Fescue

30% Forage Perennial Ryegrass

20% Forage Annual Ryegrass

10% Hard Fescue

05% Crested Wheatgrass

05% Canada Bluegrass



Sow rate: 5 to 8 pounds per 1,000 sq. ft. Or 30 pounds per acre

Foothills Grass Mix is designed for dryland, non-grazing meadows or a low maintenance utility type turf. Excellent choice for soil stabilization and erosion control where the soil has been disturbed.

Contains both sod forming and bunch-type, perennial, cool season grasses. The deep aggressive root system makes this mixture very drought-cold and heat tolerant. Grass blade width varies from fine to medium-wide, and coloring varies from dark-green to medium-green. This mixture grows in sun and is very shade tolerant.

Animals will graze on this mixture and find it very palatable however it does contain a small amount of endophytes. If it is used for grazing, animals should be regularly moved from this area into pasture that is endophyte free. This mixture does not harm wandering, grazing animals or wildlife.

Best results will be obtained by preparing the soil prior to planting the seed, adding soil amendments and fertilizers at root level. Seed must be covered to germinate. Keep the seed bed consistently moist until germination is complete, and the grass is completely established. Maintain a height of 3 inches if mowed. Rocky Mountain Wildflowers or California Poppies may be added to this mixture for a meadow appearance. In such case mow in late summer to redistribute flower and grass seed.
