Buffalograss

*Seeding rate: 5 lbs per 1000 sq. Ft.
215 lbs per acre*



This native, warm season, perennial, short grass is an important constituent on medium and fine textured soils. Buffalo grass and blue grama are very common associates, increasing with overgrazing on moderately fine soils.

Once established, it creates a tight sod. Due to its good soil cover, and drought resistance. Buffalo grass is frequently favored for erosion control on soils containing very little sand. In addition, this low-growing grass has been used successfully to seed lawn, picnic areas, and airport runways.

Used for pasture, range and low-maintenance lawns. A short growing, warm season, sod-forming grass. Buffalo grass needs little or no fertilizer. Water requirements after establishment is very low. Generally pest and disease free.

Treated seed germinates much faster than untreated.
