Colorado High Altitude Grass Mix

*Seeding rate: 4 to 5 lbs per 1000 sq. Ft.
Over seeding rate: 3 lbs per 1000 sq. Ft.*

Colorado High Altitude grass mix is designed for all altitudes in the Rocky Mountain and plains areas.

Very drought tolerant, low growing mixture that may be mowed or left to appear more natural.

These cool-season grasses are dark green with blade widths ranging from very fine to medium.

Colorado High Altitude grass mix can be used for a mountain or plains utility lawn or as a multipurpose mixture on hills, slopes, roadsides, meadows and for wildlife areas. It may be over seeded into established natural areas or any area in need of a low-growing native appearing grass mixture.

Sow the seed anytime during the growing season. Best results will occur with the addition of a starter fertilizer, however, because this mixture is so adaptable it will grow on rather poor unfertile, dry soils. As with all seed, the bed should be kept moist until all the grasses have germinated and established. To thicken the growth, fertilize in the spring and fall with a high nitrogen fertilizer.
