Kentucky Bluegrass

98/85 Common

Kentucky Bluegrass is hardy, slow to germinate. Must be kept well watered through establishment. Blends in well with older lawns. Seed must be covered with 1/8 inch of soil to germinate.

Taken from old established fields of bluegrass in South Dakota. These varieties in general carry no improvements such as drought or disease-resistance.

This variety goes dormant during hot dry spells, is of a medium green in color. **Common Kentucky Bluegrass 98/85** is a high seed producer on a short prostrate plant. Maintain a mow height between 2 and 3 inches.



*Sow rate: 5 to 7 lbs per 1000 sq. Ft.
Over seeding rate: 4 lbs per 1000 sq. Ft.*
