# Mountain Grass Mix



- 40% Annual Ryegrass*
- 20% Triticale*
- 15% Bull Tall Fescue*
- 10% Kentucky Bluegrass*
- 05% Smooth Bromegrass*
- 05% Timothy*
- 05% White Dutch Clover*

**Sow rate: 5 to 7 pounds per 1,000 sq. Ft.  
20 to 30 pounds per acre**

A blend of native, perennial, sod-forming grasses, used for over seeding natural landscapes, erosion control, revegetating rangelands and soil stabilization. Deep rooted, drought and cold tolerant with both fine and medium bladed grasses. Contains a legume for natural nitrogen fixation. Grows on a variety of soil types, with or without irrigation. Non-irrigated stands should have better soil conditions and sowing of seed should take place prior to

a rainy season. Requires even, consistent moisture to germinate and establish. Palatable and nutritious for all classes of livestock and wildlife. Grasses in this mixture do not contain endophyte fungi. Do not over graze, use in pasture rotation. Excellent for high altitude meadows and ranges. Rocky mountain flowers may be added to this mixture for color.
