Multipurpose Sudangrass

Super Sugar - is an early maturing (Sorgo-Sorghum) X Sudangrass Hybrid-that has exhibited excellent seedling vigor rapid growth small juicy stems, and succulent leaves. Superb characteristics for grazing and hay.

The real extra value comes from the feeding of **Super Sugar**. Cattle seem to prefer it over other Sudangrass types because of the enhanced “sweet”

taste gained from the sorgho breeding. It is very palatable, with small stems and broad succulent leaves. In pasture or in hay, you get more consumption and less waste. Superior as a hay or green-chop, superb as a pasture, excellent as a standing hay, 8 to 10 tons per acre.

Crop Management

In dryland or irrigated production, well-prepared pre-fertilized seedbeds are preferred

for maximum production. Plant only after soil temperatures reach a minimum of 55 to 60 degrees. For grazing, many producers prefer rows to reduce livestock “walking down” plants. Others will flat-break and broadcast.

Graze only after height reaches a minimum of 18” to leave adequate stubble for faster re-growth. Top dressing of nitrogen after cutting or grazing will enhance re-growth yields.
